

ICAR-NRCE organizes equine health camp and interactive meet of equine owners as part of “Jai Kisan Jai Vigyan Week” Celebration

ICAR-National Research Center on Equines organized equine health camp and interactive meet of equine owners at the village Umra in Hansi tehsil, Hisar on December 26, 2015 as part of “Jai Kisan Jai Vigyan Week” celebration. “Jai Kisan Jai Vigyan Week” is being celebrated from 23 to 29 December on the birth anniversary of the Shri Atal Bihari Vajpayee and Late Shri Chaudhary Charan Singh, two former Prime Ministers of India, keeping in view of their immense contribution for promoting use of science for the welfare of farmers. During the equine health camp organized at village Umra, Hisar, 13 equines were examined for various ailments by a multidisciplinary team of scientists and technical officer from the centre. Deworming tablets, antiseptic lotion, medicine was provided to equine owners free of cost and emergency treatment was given on the spot to three sick equines. The bio-samples were also collected from the animals for disease epidemiological studies.
