Report on the training Programme conducted at EPC Bikaner from 18-20 July 2019

Athree day training programme on "Training of Veterinary Officers on Artificial Insemination in Equines" under the theme of "Network Approach for the Genetic Improvement of Indigenous Horses" has been organized for the veterinarians at Equine Production campus, ICAR-NRC on Equines, Bikaner, Rajasthan from 18-20 July 2019 under the Chairmanship of Dr BN Tripathi, Director, ICAR-NRC on Equines, Hisar, Haryana.
