

**Three days training programme for Medical, Veterinary and Wildlife professionals on
“Diagnosis of important bacterial, parasitic and viral zoonotic diseases” from 01-03rd
March, 2023 at ICAR-NRC on Equines, Hisar, Haryana**

ICAR-National Research Centre on Equines (NRCE), Hisar, Haryana is one of the Regional Coordinators under “National One Health Program for Prevention and Control of Zoonotic Diseases (NOHP-CZ)” initiated by National Centre for Disease Control (NDC), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The objective of the programme is to strengthen the inter-sectoral coordination for prevention and control of zoonotic diseases in the country. In this direction, ICAR-NRCE will be organizing a 3 days training programme for Medical, Veterinary and Wildlife professionals on “Diagnosis of important bacterial, parasitic and viral zoonotic diseases” from 01 to 03rd March, 2023 to strengthen their diagnostic skills and capacity. The training programme will include expert lectures and hands-on-training on diagnosis of important zoonotic diseases viz., Glanders, Tuberculosis, Leptospirosis, Japanese Encephalitis Poxvirus diseases, Trypanosomosis and Toxoplasmosis. A total of 35 participants including 15 Medical Officers, 15 Veterinary Officers and 5 Wildlife Officers from Himachal Pradesh and Delhi are expected to participate in this training programme.
