## Three days training programme for Medical, Veterinary and Wildlife professionals on "Diagnosis of important bacterial, parasitic and viral zoonotic diseases" from 01-03<sup>rd</sup> March, 2023 at ICAR-NRC on Equines, Hisar, Haryana

ICAR-National Research Centre on Equines (NRCE), Hisar, Haryana is one of the Regional Coordinators under "National One Health Program for Prevention and Control of Zoonotic Diseases (NOHP-CZ)" initiated by National Centre for Disease Control (NDC), Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The objective of the programme is to strengthen the inter-sectoral coordination for prevention and control of zoonotic diseases in the country. In this direction, ICAR-NRCE will be organizing a 3 days training programme for Medical, Veterinary and Wildlife professionals on "Diagnosis of important bacterial, parasitic and viral zoonotic diseases" from 01 to 03<sup>rd</sup> March, 2023 to strengthen their diagnostic skills and capacity. The training programme will include expert lectures and hands-on-training on diagnosis of important zoonotic diseases *viz.*, Glanders, Tuberculosis, Leptospirosis, Japanese Encephalitis Poxvirus diseases, Trypanosomosis and Toxoplasmosis. A total of 35 participants including 15 Medical Officers, 15 Veterinary Officers and 5 Wildlife Officers from Himachal Pradesh and Delhi are expected to participate in this training programme.
