**1. Comprehensive warranty**

Comprehensive warranty shall include preventive maintenance including calibration as per technical/ service /operational manual of the manufacturer, service charges and spares,. During the warranty period commencing from date of the successful completion of warranty period, Service personnel shall visit each consignee site as recommended in the manufacturer's technical/ service /operational manual, at least once in six months. warranty shall not be including the consumables .Further there will be 98% uptime warranty during warranty period on 24 (hrs) X 7 (days) X 365 (days) basis, with penalty, to extend warranty period by double the downtime period.

2. **Service centres** Details of Service outlets in India to render services for equipment to be furnished to buyer/consignees with complete address ,telephone numbers, e mails etc at time of making the supplies .It shall be the responsibility of seller to ensure that authorized service centres are available to cater to the areas where supplies are made within reasonable distance from where the service calls can be handled .Details of toll free numbers for service call and online registration of service requests also to be provided buyer/consignee at the time of supplies
3. **Source of supply:** It shall be responsibility of seller to provide Documents regarding source of equipments such as copy of Performa invoice or any other documents to establish that the products supplied are manufactured by OEM indicated and sourced from them .
4. **Packing and Marking** Medical equipments being very delicate and sensitive packing for the goods should be strong and durable enough to withstand transit including transshipment (if any), rough handling, open storage etc. without any damage, deterioration etc. .The size, weights and volumes of the packing cases, remoteness of the final destination of the goods, availability or otherwise of transport and handling facilities at all points during transit up to final destination,. Quality of packing, the manner of marking within & outside the packages and provision of accompanying documentation shall take in to consideration the type of medical equipments being supplied. The accessories shall be suitably labelled and packed .Each of the package shall be marked on three sides with indelible paint of proper quality: indicating contract number and date , brief description of goods including quantity ,. Packing list reference number , country of

origin of goods and any other relevant details

5. **Spare Parts** : Seller shall provide materials, information etc. pertaining to spare parts manufactured and supplied by the OEM . It shall be ensured that the required spares are available for purchase at least for 10 years from date of supplies .In case due to any reasons the production of the spare parts is discontinued sufficient advance notice should be given to the buyer/consignee before such discontinuation to provide adequate time to purchase the required spare parts etc. Further, OEM and their service centres/dealers shall carry sufficient inventories to assure ex-stock supply of consumables and spares for the equipments so that the same are available.

OEM or reseller shall always accord most favoured client status to the buyer/consignee and shall give the most competitive price for spares and consumables of its machines/equipments supplied

6. **Installation, Training, Manuals** Seller shall be responsible to carry out Installation & commissioning, Supervision and Demonstration of the They shall provide required jigs and tools for assembly, minor civil works for the completion of the installation and Training of Consignee's representatives for operating and maintaining the equipment and Supplying required number of operation & maintenance manual for the goods. In case the category parameters are specifying any requirements regarding the installations , training and manuals the same shall also be applicable

4. The delivery of goods/equipment shall be F.O.R. NRCE, Hisar. The firm should clearly mention the delivery period, which normally should not be more than 45 days from the date of issue of order contract.
5. Bid should be inclusive of all packing and other forwarding expenses, freight insurance charges. The firms should give the rates of items per unit also. The prices quoted shall remain firm & fixed during their currency of the contract. The rates and prices quoted shall be in Indian rupees only. **SPECIFICATIONS FOR INVERTED TRINOCULAR FLUORESCENCE MICROSCOPE**

1. **Body:** An inverted trinocular microscope suitable for fluorescence microscopy with options for future upgradation.
2. **Observation technique:** Microscope should be equipped with facility for bright field, phase contrast, and fluorescence (with three position filters and one separate for bright field/equivalent technology) observation.
3. **Nosepiece:** It should be a quintuple or sextuple revolving nosepiece (or better) to accommodate five or six objectives.
4. **Eyepiece Tube:** A trinocular-type eyepiece tube with two eyepieces for viewing the specimen and the third tube for connecting to a microscope camera (with a camera port and adapter to mount the camera).
5. **Eyepiece:**
  - The eyepiece tube should be at an inclination of 45 degrees for comfortable viewing.
  - Eyepieces should have a 360° rotatable viewing head with 50–75 mm of adjustable inter-pupillary distance (IPD).
  - Eyepiece magnification should be 10X with a FOV of 22 mm or better
6. **Light source:** The light source should be LED illumination for both bright field and fluorescence microscopy with a life time of 50,000 hrs or more.
7. **Condenser:** Condenser should be a long working distance condenser with a working distance of 70–75 mm and NA 0.3mm.
8. **Mechanical stage:** The mechanical stage should be fitted with a universal holder (i.e., holders for slides, tissue culture flasks, tissue culture plates, etc.).
9. **Objectives:** Minimum two objectives (10X and 20X) each suitable for observing specimens under bright field, phase contrast, and fluorescence modes should be provided with the microscope.
10. **Fluorescence filters:** Minimum one fluorescence filter (Blue Filter, ~420–495 nm) should be provided with a microscope, or the microscope should have equivalent technology for viewing the samples (creating an excitation wavelength) within the range of ~420– 495 nm.
11. **Camera:** A 5-6 megapixel CCD or CMOS camera (or even a better) with a recordable pixel of 2700–2900 x 2000–2200 (or better), bit depth range of 10-12 bit (or better) and Pixel size range of at least 2-3 X 2-3 (or better). The necessary ports for connecting the camera to microscope and computer should be present/ provided.
12. **Software:** Software required for operating the camera with facilities for point-to-point measurement, auto white balance, auto exposure option, and photo merge option should be provided along with the microscope.
13. **UPS:** A 2KVA UPS along with batteries should be supplied with the microscope.

14. **Make and model number:** The make and model number of the microscope, camera and software should be clearly mentioned in the bid and the same models should be available on the firm's website.
15. **Product catalogue:** Product catalogue for microscope, camera and software should be provided along with tender document.
16. **Facility for future upgradation:** The quoted microscope should be capable of future upgrades. The facility for installation of UV filter (330–390 nm) and green filter (510– 570 nm) or equivalent technology in the future should be available in the model quoted by the firm, and the **same should be clearly mentioned in the tender quote**. A microscope that does not have the facility for future upgrades will not be considered.
17. **Computer:** Branded computer with an i5 or i7 processor, 500 HDD or SSD, 4 GB RAM, keyboard, mouse, and a 21 or 24-inch colour LED monitor will be provided by the institute/laboratory for installation of software.
18. **Power requirement:** Equipment should work at 220-230V and 50 HZ, or it should have suitable technology to work at Indian conditions.
19. **Manufacturer:** The microscope, camera, and image analysis software should be from the same manufacturer for better compatibility and future upgradability. All USB interfaces, cables, power cords, and adapters required for operation should be provided.
20. **Authorization:** If the bidder is a manufacturer, relevant documents establishing the manufacturer of the tendered product should be submitted along with the bid. If the bidder is an authorized distributor, a valid authorization certificate issued by the manufacturer should be submitted along with the bid.
21. **Certification:** The quoted model of the microscope should have international quality standards and certification (USFDA/CE certification). The bidder should also submit a low voltage directive/ a medical directive (98/79/EC) / TUV declaration certificate.
22. **User list:** The firm should submit a user list (minimum 5 installations) of the quoted model (user list of other models are not required).
23. **Compliance statement:** A compliance statement sheet (for the quoted model only) pertaining to each parameter in the specifications should be provided.
24. **Warranty:** The microscope should come with a warranty of one year or more.
25. **Installation and demonstration:** Installation, commissioning, and demonstration of the working of equipment as per the parameters indented should be done at the ICAR-NRCE, Hisar, Haryana laboratory.
