Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. 3. The Director, NRCE, Hisar reserves the right to accept or reject all or any of the bid in part or full without assigning any reason.

4. The delivery of goods/equipment shall be F.O.R. NRCE, Hisar for period of one year from the issuance of order. The firm should clearly mention the delivery period, which normally should not be more than 15 days from the date of issue of order contract and firm should supply the Liquid Nitrogen (LN2) Gases as per specification of the tender documents (Annexure I).
5. Bid should be inclusive of all packing and other forwarding expenses, freight insurance charges. The firms should give the rates of items per unit also. The prices quoted shall remain firm & fixed during their currency of the contract. The rates and prices quoted shall be in Indian rupees only. All duties, taxes etc. payable should be included in the quoted prices.
