

Training Program on " Surveillance and Diagnosis of Zoonotic Diseases Through One Health Approach "

The ICAR-National Research Centre on Equines (ICAR-NRCE) is pleased to announce an upcoming five-day training program titled " **Surveillance and Diagnosis of Zoonotic Diseases Through One Health Approach**", scheduled to take place from **November 19 to 23, 2024**, at the ICAR-NRCE campus in Hisar.

This training program aims to strengthen interdisciplinary collaboration among medical professionals, veterinarians, and wild life officers, equipping them with the knowledge and skills required to effectively address zoonotic diseases through a holistic One Health approach.

This time, the program has specifically targeted participants from **Uttar Pradesh state**, receiving an encouraging response with **24 participants**, including medical, veterinary, and wildlife professionals, registering for the event. Participants will benefit from a carefully designed agenda that includes lectures and hands-on training sessions focusing on critical zoonotic diseases such as tuberculosis, brucellosis, rabies, glanders, wildlife zoonoses, and zoonotic parasitic diseases.

The inauguration ceremony will be held at the ICAR-NRCE Auditorium and will feature **Dr Swapna Gehlot, Chief Medical Officer, Hisar**, as the Chief Guest, and **Dr Subhash Jangra., Deputy Director, Animal Husbandry Department, Hisar**, as the Guest of Honour. **Dr T.K.
